- Hours of use shall extend from one hour after sunrise until one hour after sunset.
- Alcoholic beverages cannot be served or sold.
- Rides, live bands, and disc jockeys are prohibited.

ORDINANCE NO. 2093

ORDINANCE APPROVING TEMPORARY USE PERMIT FOR EVENTS ON CITY-OWNED PROPERTY (SECOND STREET AND WARRENVILLE ROAD)

WHEREAS, the City of Warrenville owns certain properties located at the northwest corner of Second Street and Warrenville Road in the City of Warrenville, which properties are identified on Exhibit 1 attached hereto and made a part hereof (hereinafter referred to as the "Subject Property"); and

WHEREAS, the City has applied for a blanket temporary use permit for the properties, which permit would allow the City to authorize short-term or temporary events on the Subject Property; and

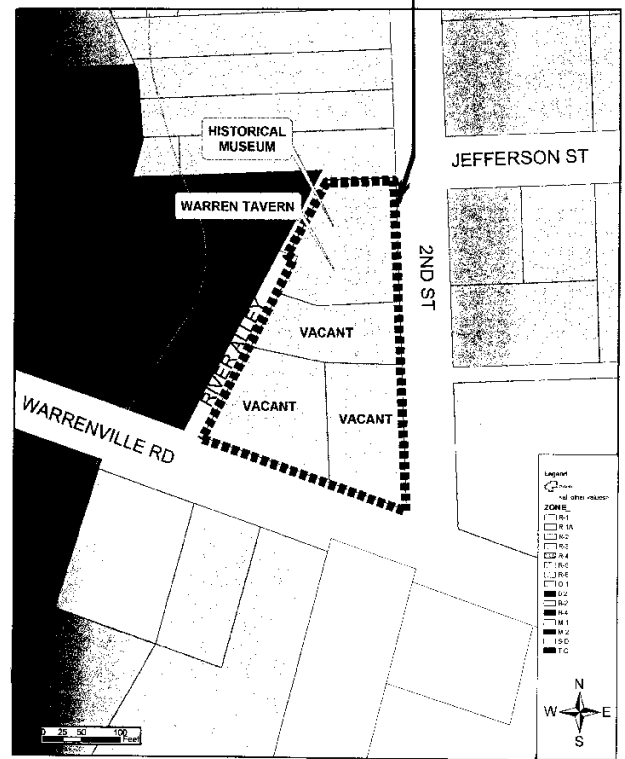
WHEREAS, the Warrenville Plan Commission duly called, noticed and held a public hearing relating to said application and subsequently made its recommendation that the City Council approve said application; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council find and hereby declare that it is in the best interests of the City and its residents to accept the recommendation of the Plan Commission and approve the application as set forth hereinbelow;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WARRENVILLE, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: The foregoing recitals shall be, and they are hereby, incorporated as findings of fact as if said recitals were fully set forth herein.

SECTION TWO: A blanket temporary use permit for the Subject Property shall be and is hereby approved pursuant to Section 1.D.4 of the Zoning Ordinance of the City, subject to the following conditions:

- A. The blanket temporary use permit shall be subject to compliance with the Recommended Restrictions set forth in the memorandum of July 9, 2003 from Jennifer McMahon to John Coakley, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and made a part hereof.
- B. The City Council may, at any time, revoke this blanket temporary use permit by an affirmative vote of the majority of the aldermen then holding office on the City Council.

SECTION THREE: Any policy, resolution or ordinance of the City which conflicts with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
