SUBJECT: DISPOSAL REQUEST OF SURPLUS RADAR UNITS
DATE: May 21, 2019

The Police Department has rotated five (5) mobile radar units out of service and replaced them with new units. The former units either no longer work or are broken, and have not been recommended for repair because of the service age, lack of part availability and would not prove to be cost-effective.

The certification vendor for the Police Department, Radar Man, Inc., has agreed to take the former radar units, and, in exchange, provide an open-ended account credit to the City for future purchases in an amount estimated to be between \$500 and \$1000.

After conferring with City attorneys on this topic, their office has drafted an ordinance to dispose of the former radar units in the above-described manner. Attached to this memo is that draft ordinance, and an exhibit list prepared by the Police Department describing the surplus units.

The request to the Public Safety & Finance Committee is being made to adopt the attached ordinance to dispose of the surplus radar units by turning them over to Radar Man, Inc., and, in exchange, receive an open-ended credit on our account for future purchases. Purchases for certification of our radar units will be made in the next year, to utilize the account credit.

**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE DISPOSAL OF
SURPLUS RADAR UNITS OWNED BY THE CITY OF WARRENVILLE**

WHEREAS, the City is a home rule municipal corporation pursuant to Article VII, Section 6(a) of the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970; and

WHEREAS, the City is the owner of five radar units described in detail in Exhibit A, attached to and, by this reference, made a part of this Ordinance ("Surplus Property"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City's power under applicable law, including Section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, and the home rule powers of the City, the Mayor and the City Council have determined that the Surplus Property is no longer necessary or useful to, or for the best interests of the City because it is obsolete and the Surplus Property should be disposed of in the manner set forth in this Ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF WARRENVILLE, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Recitals. The recitals listed above are incorporated in this Ordinance as if fully set forth in this Ordinance.

SECTION 2: Declaration of Surplus Property. Pursuant to Section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, and the City's home rule powers, the City Council declares that the Surplus Property is no longer necessary or useful to, or in the best interests of, the City.

SECTION 3: Authorization to Dispose of Surplus Property. The Chief of Police, or his designee, is hereby authorized to dispose of the Surplus Property by conveying the Surplus Property to Radar Man, Inc. in exchange for an account credit in the name of the City in the estimated total amount of between \$500 and \$1000 to be used for future purchases by the City.

SECTION 4: Execution of Required Documentation. The Chief of Police, or his designee, is authorized to execute, on behalf of the City, the documents necessary to complete the disposition of the Surplus Property authorized pursuant to Section 3 of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect following its passage by a majority of the members of the city council then holding office and approval in the manner provided by law.
