

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER
PURSUANT TO DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY
CITY OF WARRENVILLE
MARCH 25, 2020

I, Mayor David Brummel, do hereby issue the following supplemental emergency order for the City of Warrenville this 25th day of March, 2020 (“**Supplemental Order**”).

Introduction

On March 16, 2020, I issued a Declaration of Emergency pursuant to the authority granted to me by: Chapter 2 of Title 4 of the Warrenville City Code, as amended (“*City Code*”); Section 11-1-6 of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-1-6; and Section 11 of the Illinois Emergency Management Act, 20 ILCS 3305/11 to address the health threat posed by the COVID-19 pandemic (“*Declaration*”).

The Declaration granted and reserved emergency powers to the Mayor during the pendency of the civil emergency, including the right to issue additional emergency regulations and orders in furtherance of the Declaration.

The corporate authorities of the City of Warrenville subsequently approved and extended the duration of the Declaration through and until the adjournment of the next regular, special, or emergency meeting of the corporate authorities of the City.

In order to prevent the spread of COVID-19 in the City, and to further protect the residents of the City from disease and death, I find that it is necessary to issue a supplemental emergency order as set forth below. Nothing in the supplemental Order shall modify or limit the actions and authority previously established by the Declaration.

Supplemental Order

I hereby direct and order as follows:

1. The issuance of solicitation licenses by the City pursuant to Chapter 4 of Title 3 of the City Code is suspended for the duration of the Declaration; provided, however, the suspension shall apply only to applications for door-to-door solicitation licenses.

This Supplemental Order shall take effect immediately, and run concurrently with the term of the Declaration of Civil Emergency unless rescinded or superseded by my order or a majority vote of the corporate authorities at any regular or emergency meeting thereof.
