MINUTES

A. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Sugrue called the meeting to order at 7:06 p.m.

B. ROLL CALL

Members Present: Chair Jerry Sugrue, Commissioners Amy Murphy, Kate Perkins, and Harlan Davis.

Also Present: Alderman Bill Weidner, and Staff Liaison Kristin Youngmeyer.

C. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Commissioner Murphy made a motion to approve the minutes of the March 10, 2020, meeting, seconded by Commissioner Perkins. Motion was approved.

D. CITIZEN COMMENTS

None.

E. STAFF REPORT

Staff Liaison Youngmeyer shared that City activities and events in April are either cancelled or postponed, and Administration is waiting to get more information on whether or not Stay at Home will be extended before making a decision on the viability of events after April 30th.

F. BUSINESS OF MEETING

1. 2020 Bike Rodeo

Commissioners discussed whether or not it was viable to move forward with scheduling the Bike Rodeo, in light of the pandemic and not knowing whether or not the Governor would be extending the Stay at Home order past May.

After discussion, Kate Perkins motioned to recommend the Bike Rodeo be canceled, seconded by Jerry Sugrue. The motion passed unanimously. This recommendation to City Council was based on the pandemic and the Commissioners anticipating the need to continue practicing social distancing to protect the health of the community, and minimize the spread of the virus.

2. May Bike/Walk to School Day

Commissioner Perkins reported if the Stay at Home order was lifted the school would still try to hold the event.

G. COMMISSIONER COMMENTS

Commissioner Sugrue observed that some kids riding bikes were not pressing buttons at the cross walk, thinking because of social distancing practices. He suggested that the group research into contact-less cross walk options.

Commissioner Perkins noticed the bike rack at City Hall was removed due to current concrete work around the building, and asked if a temporary bike rack could be put in till the permanent one is reinstalled.

H. ADJOURN

Commissioner Davis made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:50 p.m. Commissioner Murphy seconded the motion, and it was unanimously approved.
