

RESOLUTION NO. R2020-66

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE EXTENSION OF THE MARCH 16, 2020  
DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY UNTIL THE ADJOURNMENT OF THE NEXT  
REGULAR, SPECIAL, OR EMERGENCY MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL**

WHEREAS, on January 31, 2020, the Secretary of HHS declared a public health emergency for the entire United States of America concerning COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2020, Governor Pritzker issued a disaster proclamation concerning the spread of COVID-19 in Illinois; and

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2020, WHO declared that the spread of COVID-19 is a global pandemic; and

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, the President of the United States declared a national emergency concerning the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020, Mayor Brummel issued a Declaration of Emergency, attached to and, by this reference, made a part of this Resolution as Exhibit A ("**Declaration of Emergency**"); and

WHEREAS, Section 4-2-5 of the Warrenville City Code ("**City Code**") provides that a declaration of emergency expires and automatically terminates not later than: (i) the adjournment of the first regular or special meeting of the City Council; or (ii) seven days after the declaration is issued, whichever occurs first; provided, however, the City Council may by motion extend the duration of a declaration of emergency; and

WHEREAS, on March 23, 2020, April 6, 2020, April 13, 2020 (Resolution No. R2020-22), April 20, 2020 (Resolution No. R2020-23), May 4, 2020 (Resolution No. R2020-26), May 18, 2020 (Resolution No. R2020-30), June 1, 2020 (Resolution No. R2020-34), June 15, 2020 (R2020-36), July 6, 2020 (Resolution No. R2020-39), July 20, 2020 (Resolution No. R2020-41), August 3, 2020 (Resolution No. R2020-45), August 17, 2020 (Resolution No. R2020-48), September 8, 2020 (Resolution No. R2020-53), September 21, 2020 (Resolution No. R2020-55), October 5, 2020 (Resolution No. R2020-58), October 19, 2020 (Resolution No. R2020-62), and November 2, 2020 (Resolution No. R2020-64) the City Council voted to extend the duration of the Declaration of Emergency to the adjournment of the next regular, special, or emergency meeting of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, COVID-19 continues to spread in Illinois where there are now more than 524,000 confirmed cases and more than 10,400 people have died; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it will serve and be in the best interest of the City and its residents to further extend the duration of the Declaration of Emergency, including any and all orders and supplemental orders issued by the Mayor pursuant to the Declaration of Emergency, to the adjournment of the next regular, special, or emergency meeting of the City Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF WARRENVILLE, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1: Recitals.** The recitals listed above are incorporated in this Resolution as if fully set forth in this Resolution.

**SECTION 2: Extension of the Declaration of Emergency.** The City Council hereby approves the extension the Declaration of Emergency, including any and all orders and supplemental orders issued by the Mayor pursuant to the Declaration of Emergency, until the adjournment of the next regular, special, or emergency meeting of the City Council.

**SECTION 3. Effective Date.** This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
