Old Town Redevelopment Site #2 Preliminary Planning Advisory Group Meeting Update

On Thursday June 17th, the Old Town Redevelopment Site #2 Preliminary Site Planning Advisory Group met in person to (i) review the history of the City's involvement with the former gas station site and the City's overall goals for the property, and (ii) to review three different site redevelopment alternatives for the site. The Advisory Group's feedback on land use, site and building design, parking, and traffic and circulation issues will be used to refine a preliminary site plan to be presented at a public information and input meeting in July, and then to the City Council at a Committee of the Whole meeting shortly thereafter.

Trailhead Project Update

On Thursday June 17th, the Community and Economic Development Director Ron Mentzer and Senior Civil Engineer Kristine Hocking attended the Warrenville Park District's regular board meeting where they provided an update and addressed questions regarding the scope and status of the City's Trailhead Project. The discussion was very positive. The Park District Board members who provided comment expressed genuine appreciation for the City's efforts to design the revised project in a manner that effectively addresses Park District concerns and needs. Staff will be presenting an update on this project at the July 12, 2021, Community Development Committee of the Whole Meeting.

Forest Preserve Master Plan Input Request

The DuPage County Forest Preserve District is requesting input from stakeholders about the preserves to help inform and develop the master plan recommendations.
