

RESOLUTION NO. R2022-11

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE CITY OF WARRENVILLE'S APPLICATION FOR THE DUPAGE COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City is a home rule municipal corporation pursuant to Article VII, Section 6(a) of the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970; and

WHEREAS, the DuPage County Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program ("**CDBG Program**") provides grants to communities to address unique community development needs in areas where at least 45.36 percent of the population has low to moderate income, as updated by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) from time to time ("**Grant Funding**"); and

WHEREAS, the City identified the need to perform resurfacing, curb and gutter, and sidewalk replacement work related to Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) improvements in the Summerlakes Subdivision square court areas ("**Sidewalk Improvements**"), the estimated cost of which Sidewalk Improvements was \$440,000, but was increased to \$1,295,633 per an updated engineer's estimate completed November 19, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the City initially applied to the CDBG Program on October 11, 2019 for grant funding for the Sidewalk Improvements in the amount of \$400,000, which application was later revised to increase the amount requested to \$600,000 based on the updated engineer's cost estimated and an updated project scope clarified in a letter to the County dated December 2, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the City has been notified of a Grant Funding award that will be included in the CDBG Program 2022 program year; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Council have determined that it is in the best interest of the City and the public to support the Projects and authorize the City to execute a grant funding agreement for the Grant Funding;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF WARRENVILLE, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Recitals. The recitals listed above are incorporated in this Resolution as if fully set forth in this Resolution.

SECTION 2: Support for the Sidewalk Improvements. The City Council hereby supports the Sidewalk Improvements.

SECTION 3: Designation of Grant Signatory and Authorization to Execute the Grant Funding Agreement. The City Council hereby designates the City's Assistant Community Development Director as the City's CDBG Program grant signatory. The Assistant Community Development Director is authorized to execute a grant funding agreement for the Grant Funding, and all corresponding documentation, on behalf of the City.

SECTION 4: Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect following its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
