NOMINATING PETITIONS FOR APRIL 4, 2023 CONSOLIDATED ELECTION AVAILABLE AT CITY HALL

WARRENVILLE, IL – Nominating petitions for anyone wishing to run for office for the Consolidated Election to be held Tuesday, April 4, 2023, will be available at City Hall, 3S258 Manning Avenue, Warrenville, Illinois, during regular office hours: Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., and on the City website, www.warrenville.il.us/322/Elections, on and after September 20, 2022.

Offices to be elected at the Consolidated Election are as follows: One (1) City Treasurer (pending the outcome of a public question on the November 8, 2022 ballot); One (1) Alderman from Ward 1, Ward 2, Ward 3, and Ward 4 to serve a four (4) year term expiring April 30, 2027; and One (1) Alderman from Ward 1 to fill a two (2) year unexpired term expiring April 30, 2025. Independent candidates seeking election at the April 4, 2023, Consolidated Election may circulate nomination papers no earlier than September 20, 2022.

Nominating Petitions must be filed with the City Clerk or Deputy City Clerk at City Hall during normal business hours from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. The first day to file nominating papers is December 12, 2022. The last day to file is December 19, 2022. A current receipt for filing a statement of economic interest with the DuPage County Clerk must be included with submitted

petitions no later than 5:00 p.m., December 19, 2022. Objections to nominating petitions may be filed until December 28, 2022.

Position on the ballot will be determined by when the nominating papers are filed with the City Clerk or Deputy City Clerk. If more than one candidate files simultaneously for the same office, a lottery will be held on December 28, 2022, at 10:00 a.m. to determine ballot placement.
