

RESOLUTION NO. R2022-68

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING THE CHIEF OF POLICE

WHEREAS, the City is a home rule municipal corporation pursuant to Article VII, Section 6(a) of the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970; and

WHEREAS, the City’s current Chief of Police, Raymond Turano, is retiring from his position, effective January 6, 2023 (“**Current Police Chief**”); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 4-1-1 of the Warrenville City Code, as amended, the Chief of Police shall be appointed by the Mayor and the City Council; and

WHEREAS, after a thorough search and evaluation process, the Mayor and the City Council now desire to appoint Samuel Bonilla as Chief of Police, effective November 28, 2022 (“**New Police Chief**”); and

WHEREAS, during the period between November 28, 2022 and January 6, 2023, the Current Police Chief will assist in the transition of the Police Department to the New Police Chief; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Council have determined that it is in the best interest of the City and the public to appoint Samuel Bonilla as Police Chief in the best interests of the City and the public;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF WARRENVILLE, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Recitals. The recitals listed above are incorporated in this Resolution as if fully set forth in this Resolution.

SECTION 2: Appointment. The Mayor and City Council hereby appoint Samuel Bonilla as Chief of Police of the City of Warrenville, effective November 28, 2022, pursuant to Section 4-1-1 of the Warrenville City Code.

SECTION 3: Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect following its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
