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About The NCS™

The National Community Survey™ (The NCS™) report is about the “livability” of Warrenville. A livable community is a place that is not simply habitable, but that is desirable. It is not only where people do live, but where they want to live. The survey was developed by the experts from National Research Center at Polco.

Great communities are partnerships of the government, private sector, community-based organizations and residents, all geographically connected. The NCS captures residents’ opinions considering ten central facets of a community:

- Economy
- Mobility
- Community Design
- Utilities
- Safety
- Natural Environment
- Parks and Recreation
- Health and Wellness
- Education, Arts, and Culture
- Inclusivity and Engagement

The report provides the opinions of a representative sample of 448 residents of the City of Warrenville collected from March 2nd, 2023 to April 13th, 2023. The margin of error around any reported percentage is 5% for all respondents and the response rate for the 2023 survey was 16%. Survey results were weighted so that the demographic profile of respondents was representative of the demographic profile of adults in Warrenville.



How the results are reported

For the most part, the percentages presented in the following tabs represent the “percent positive.” Most commonly, the percent positive is the combination of the top two most positive response options (i.e., excellent/good, very safe/somewhat safe, etc.). On many of the questions in the survey respondents may answer “don’t know.” The proportion of respondents giving this reply is shown in the full set of responses included in the tab “Complete data.” However, these responses have been removed from the analyses presented in most of the tabs. In other words, the tables and graphs display the responses from respondents who had an opinion about a specific item.

Comparisons to benchmarks

NRC’s database of comparative resident opinion is comprised of resident perspectives gathered in surveys from over 600 communities whose residents evaluated the same kinds of topics on The National Community Survey. The comparison evaluations are from the most recent survey completed in each community in the last five years. NRC adds the latest results quickly upon survey completion, keeping the benchmark data fresh and relevant. The communities in the database represent a wide geographic and population range. In each tab, Warrenville’s results are noted as being “higher” than the benchmark, “lower” than the benchmark, or “similar” to the benchmark, meaning that the average rating given by Warrenville residents is statistically similar to or different (greater or lesser) than the benchmark. Being rated as “higher” or “lower” than the benchmark means that Warrenville’s average rating for a particular item was more than 10 points different than the benchmark. If a rating was “much higher” or “much lower,” then Warrenville’s average rating was more than 20 points different when compared to the benchmark.

The survey was administered during the COVID-19 pandemic, a time of challenge for many local governments. While we provide comparisons to national benchmarks, it is important to note that much of the benchmark data was collected prior to the pandemic. This may impact how your City’s 2023 ratings compare to other communities’ ratings from the past five years.

Methods

Selecting survey recipients

All households within the City of Warrentville were eligible to participate in the survey. A list of all households within the zip codes serving Warrentville was purchased from Go-Dog Direct based on updated listings from the United States Postal Service. Since some of the zip codes that serve the City of Warrentville households may also serve addresses that lie outside of the community, the exact geographic location of each housing unit was compared to community boundaries using the most current municipal boundary file. Addresses located outside of the City of Warrentville boundaries were removed from the list of potential households to survey. From that list, addresses were randomly selected as survey recipients, with multi-family housing units (defined as those with a unit number) sampled at a rate of 5:3 compared to single family housing units.

An individual within each household was selected using the birthday method. The birthday method selects a person within the household by asking the “person whose birthday has most recently passed” to complete the questionnaire. The underlying assumption in this method is that day of birth has no relationship to the way people respond to surveys. This instruction was contained in the introduction of the survey.

Conducting the survey

The 2,800 randomly selected households received mailings beginning on March 2nd, 2023 and the survey remained open for 6 weeks. The first mailing was a postcard inviting the household to participate in the survey. The next mailing contained a cover letter with instructions, the survey questionnaire, and a postage-paid return envelope. All mailings included a web link to give residents the opportunity to respond to the survey online. All follow-up mailings asked those who had not completed the survey to do so and those who had already done so to refrain from completing the survey again.

The survey was available in English and Spanish. All mailings contained paragraphs in both languages instructing participants on how to complete the survey in their preferred language.

About 3% of the 2,800 mailed invitations or surveys were returned because the household address was vacant or the postal service was unable to deliver the survey as addressed. Of the remaining 2,728 households that received the invitations to participate, 448 completed the survey, providing an overall response rate of 16%. The response rate was calculated using AAPOR’s response rate #2* for mailed surveys of unnamed persons.

It is customary to describe the precision of estimates made from surveys by a “level of confidence” and accompanying “confidence interval” (or margin of error). A traditional level of confidence, and the one used here, is 95%. The 95% confidence interval can be any size and quantifies the sampling error or imprecision of the survey results because some residents’ opinions are relied on to estimate all residents’ opinions. The margin of error for the City of Warrentville survey is no greater than plus or minus five percentage points around any given percent reported for all respondents (448 completed surveys).

In addition to the randomly selected “probability sample” of households, a link to an online open participation survey was publicized by the City of Warrentville. The open participation survey was identical to the probability sample survey with two small updates; it included a map at the beginning asking where the respondent lives and a question about where they heard about the survey. The open participation survey was open to all city residents and became available on March 30th, 2023. The survey remained open for 2 weeks. The data presented in the following tabs exclude the open participation survey data, but a tab at the end provides the complete frequency of responses to questions by the open participation respondents.

Analyzing the data

Responses from mailed surveys were entered into an electronic dataset using a “key and verify” method, where all responses are entered twice and compared to each other. Any discrepancies were resolved in comparison to the original survey form. Range checks as well as other forms of quality control were also performed. Responses from surveys completed on Polco were downloaded and merged with the mailed survey responses.

The demographics of the survey respondents were compared to those found in the 2020 Census and 2022 American Community Survey estimates for adults in the City of Warrenton. The primary objective of weighting survey data is to make the survey respondents reflective of the larger population of the community. The characteristics used for weighting were age, sex, race, Hispanic origin, housing type, and housing tenure. No adjustments were made for design effects. Weights were calculated using an iterative, multiplicative raking model known as the ANES Weighting Algorithm.* The results of the weighting scheme for the probability sample are presented in the following table.

NRC aligns demographic labels with those used by the U.S. Census for reporting purposes, when possible. Some categories (e.g., age, race/Hispanic origin, housing type, and length of residency) are combined into smaller subgroups.

The survey datasets were analyzed using all or some of a combination of the Statistical Package for the Social Sciences (SPSS), R, Python, and Tableau. For the most part, the percentages presented in the reports represent the “percent positive.” The percent positive is the combination of the top two most positive response options (i.e., excellent/good, very safe/somewhat safe, essential/very important, etc.), or, in the case of resident behaviors/participation, the percent positive represents the proportion of respondents indicating “yes” or participating in an activity at least once a month.

On many of the questions in the survey respondents may answer “don’t know.” The proportion of respondents giving this reply is shown in the full set of responses included in the tab “Complete data”. However, these responses have been removed from the analyses presented in the reports. In other words, the tables and graphs display the responses from respondents who had an opinion about a specific item.

Key Findings

Residents appreciate Warrenville’s natural environment and recreational opportunities and identify priorities for climate change mitigation.

Roughly 8 in 10 survey respondents found both the overall quality of parks and recreation opportunities and the overall quality of the natural environment in Warrenville to be essential or very important for the city to focus on in the next two years. Ratings for survey items related to these areas tended to be positive and either exceeded or were on par with national averages.

About 9 in 10 residents rated the overall quality of parks and recreation as positive, similar to comparison communities. Respondents highlighted areas such as the availability of paths and walking trails (92% excellent or good) and fitness opportunities (84%), both of which were higher than counterparts across the nation. Likewise, 8 in 10 residents positively evaluated City parks, recreational opportunities, recreation programs or classes, and recreation centers or facilities, all in line with national benchmarks.

The natural environment of Warrenville was seen as an asset as well, with 9 in 10 respondents offering above-average marks for the overall quality of natural environment. Other areas receiving ratings that were higher than comparison communities were the preservation of natural areas (89% positive), water resources (87%), and Warrenville open space (83%). In a custom question unique to Warrenville, residents were asked to evaluate the importance of various City actions to address climate change. Nearly 9 in 10 residents placed high importance on protecting natural habitats, open spaces, and marsh lands. About 8 in 10 prioritized waste reduction via composting or recycling, and three-quarters of residents considered it essential or very important for the City to emphasize water conservation efforts and upgrade infrastructure to be more resistant. Additionally, about 8 in 10 felt that implementing new environmental sustainability initiatives should be a high or medium priority for Warrenville. Despite these evaluations, fewer than 4 in 10 residents gave high importance ratings to the City considering increased taxes, fees, or other funding sources to help mitigate future climate-related risks.

Residents value Warrenville’s economy and emphasize its importance.

Results relating to the economy in Warrenville tended to be positive and similar to national benchmark comparisons. Evaluations of the overall economic health of Warrenville were strong, with 8 in 10 rating this as excellent or good. Two-thirds of respondents offered positive assessments of Warrenville as a place to work, and similar ratings were seen for the City’s economic development and the overall quality of business and service establishments (both 63%). Despite these generally favorable reviews, a few areas emerged as opportunities for growth. When asked how much of a priority Warrenville should place on advancing various initiatives, 90% of respondents indicated either a high or medium priority for economic development initiatives aimed at attracting new businesses. In addition, only about half of residents offered positive ratings for Warrenville as a place to visit, and 3 in 10 gave favorable reviews for Warrenville’s shopping opportunities, both of which were lower than national averages.

While ratings for utilities are strong overall, residents point to drinking water as an area of opportunity.

Compared to other facets of livability, residents placed the highest importance on utilities, with 93% of respondents rating the overall quality of utility infrastructure as essential or very important. The overall quality of utility infrastructure was reviewed favorably by 6 in 10 respondents. High marks were also seen in evaluations for garbage collection (86%), power utility (81%), storm water management (79%), sewer services (74%), and utility billing (70%). All of these were on par with national averages. Notably, drinking water was rated positively by only half of residents, which was lower than ratings seen in comparison communities and may merit additional investigation.

Trust in Warrenville government is high, and Warrenville services are well regarded.

Over 8 in 10 respondents rated the quality of services provided by the City of Warrenville as excellent or good. City services were also highly reviewed, with 87% of respondents offering favorable marks to the overall customer service by Warrenville employees, and 76% responding positively regarding public information services. Ratings in other areas of governance were similarly strong, with many aspects scoring higher than other surveyed communities across the nation. Three-quarters of community members responded positively to Warrenville government performance in treating all residents fairly, generally acting in the best interest of the community, and being honest; a similar proportion favorably evaluated their overall confidence in Warrenville government. All of these were higher than national benchmark comparisons. About 7 in 10 residents offered positive ratings for the overall direction that Warrenville is taking, as well as for the Warrenville government being open and transparent to the public, welcoming resident involvement, and informing residents about issues facing the community—the latter three of which were also higher than national comparisons.

Facets of livability

Resident perceptions of quality and importance for each of the facets of community livability provide an overview of community strengths and challenges that are useful for planning, budgeting and performance evaluation. The charts below show the proportion of residents who rated the community facets positively for quality and the priority (importance) placed on each. Also displayed is whether local ratings were lower, similar, or higher than communities across the country (the national benchmark).


Balancing performance and importance

Every jurisdiction must balance limited resources while meeting resident needs and striving to optimize community livability. To this end, it is helpful to know what aspects of the community are most important to residents and which they perceive as being of higher or lower quality. It is especially helpful to know when a facet of livability is considered of high importance but rated as lower quality, as this should be a top priority to address.

To help guide City staff and officials with decisions on future resource allocation, resident ratings of the importance of services were compared to their ratings of the quality of these services. To identify the services perceived by residents to have relatively lower quality at the same time as relatively higher importance, all services were ranked from highest perceived quality to lowest perceived quality and from highest perceived importance to lowest perceived importance. Some services were in the top half of both lists (higher quality and higher importance); some were in the top half of one list but the bottom half of the other (higher quality and lower importance or lower quality and higher importance); and some services were in the bottom half of both lists.

Services receiving quality ratings of excellent or good by 74% or more of respondents were considered of "higher quality" and those with ratings lower than 74% were considered to be of "lower quality." Services were classified as "more important" if they were rated as essential or very important by 81% or more of respondents. Services were rated as "less important" if they received a rating of less than 81%. This classification uses the median ratings for quality and importance to divide the services in half.

The quadrants in the figure below show which community facets were given higher or lower importance ratings (right-left) and which had higher or lower quality ratings (up-down). Facets of livability falling closer to a diagonal line from the lower left to the upper right are those where performance ratings are more commensurate with resident priorities. Facets scoring closest to the lower right hand corner of the matrix (higher in importance and lower in quality) are those that may warrant further investigation to see if changes to their delivery are necessary to improve their performance. This is the key part of this chart on which to focus. Facets falling in the top left hand corner of the chart (lower in importance but higher in quality) are areas where performance may outscore resident priorities, and may be a consideration for lower resource allocation.



Quality of life

Measuring community livability starts with assessing the quality of life of those who live there, and ensuring that the community is attractive, accessible, and welcoming to all.























Methods (open participation)

As part of its participation in The National Community Survey™ (The NCST™), the City of Warrenville conducted a survey of 448 residents. Survey invitations were mailed to randomly selected households and data were collected from March 2nd, 2023 to April 13th, 2023. The results from this main survey effort represent the most robust estimate of your residents’ opinions.

After the above data collection period was underway, a link to an online open participation survey was publicized by the City of Warrenville. The open participation survey was identical to the probability sample survey with two small updates; it included question at the beginning asking if they lived within the city limits of Warrenville and also a question about where they heard about the survey. The open participation survey was open to all city residents and became available on March 30th, 2023. The survey remained open for 2 weeks and there were 151 responses.


The open participation survey data were not collected through a random sample and it is unknown who in the community was aware of the survey; therefore, a level of confidence in the representativeness of the sample cannot be estimated. However, to reduce bias where possible, these data were statistically weighted to match the demographic characteristics of the 2020 Census and 2022 American Community Survey estimates for adults in the City of Warrenville. The characteristics used for weighting were age, sex, race, Hispanic origin, housing type, and housing tenure. No adjustments were made for design effects. Weights were calculated using an iterative, multiplicative raking model known as the ANES Weighting Algorithm.* The results of the weighting scheme for the open participation survey are presented in the following table.
