



Resources for the Public Prescription Drug Recycling Program

The City has a prescription drug recycling drop-box in the Police Department lobby. Prescription drugs may be placed in this drop-box during regular business hours, **Monday through Friday, from 8 AM to 7 PM**. The drop-box is **not** available on weekends and City holidays – or when the lobby is closed.

Prescription drugs must be brought into the Department already sealed in a zip-lock style plastic bag or in its original container. ***NO loose pills can be accepted.*** Other **NON-accepted items** include: syringes, needles, lotions, liquids, and illegal street drugs. Collected drugs will be safely disposed of through a professional recycling service. For questions concerning the Warrenville drop-box, please call Police non-emergency at 630-393-2131.
