

## ORDINANCE NO. O2026-05

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A TEMPORARY USE PERMIT FOR  
WARRENVILLE PARK DISTRICT SPECIAL EVENTS IN THE YEARS 2026, 2027, AND 2028

WHEREAS, in 2026, 2027, and 2028, the Warrenville Park District ("**Park District**") desires to conduct the following events (individually, "**Event**", collectively, "**Events**") on the dates and at the times and locations set forth in **Exhibit A**, attached to and, by this reference, made a part of this Ordinance: (i) Multicultural Festival, (ii) Brew Trot, (iii) Summer Movies, (iv) Summer Daze, (v) Art on the Prairie, (vi) Fall Fest, (vii) Holly Days, (viii) Hometown Holidays Drive-Thru; and (ix) Firecracker 5K; and

WHEREAS, the Park District submitted an application to the City of Warrenville for a temporary use permit ("**Temporary Use Permit**") to allow the Events in accordance with Sections 1.D.4 and 1.D.5 of the City of Warrenville Zoning Ordinance ("**Zoning Ordinance**"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant Section 1.D.4 of the Zoning Ordinance, temporary use permits may be issued administratively by the Director of Community and Economic Development for temporary events satisfying certain criteria, including that the event be conducted between 8:00 a.m. and 8:30 p.m. Sunday through Thursday and between 8:00 a.m. and 10:30 p.m. Friday through Saturday; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1.D.5 of the Zoning Ordinance, temporary use permits may be issued for other uses by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Park District's application was referred to the Plan Commission of the City of Warrenville ("**Plan Commission**"); and

WHEREAS, at its regularly scheduled meeting on January 22, 2026, the Plan Commission heard testimony and received evidence with respect to the Park District's application and unanimously recommended approval of the Temporary Use Permit subject to certain conditions; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City's home rule powers, the Mayor and the City Council have determined that it is in the best interest of the City and the public to approve the Temporary Use Permit in accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF WARRENVILLE, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1: Recitals.** The recitals listed above are incorporated in this Ordinance as if fully set forth in this Ordinance.

**SECTION 2: Temporary Use Permit.** Subject to and contingent upon the conditions, restrictions, limitations and provisions set forth in Section 3 of this Ordinance, the City Council approves the Temporary Use Permit for the Park District to allow the Events.

**SECTION 3: Conditions.** The Temporary Use Permit approved in Section 2 of this Ordinance shall be, and is hereby, expressly subject to and contingent upon the following conditions, restrictions, limitations, and provisions:

- A. Compliance with Application Documents. The Events must be conducted in substantial conformance with the following documents (collectively, the “**Application Documents**”):
1. The Temporary Use Permit Application, signed by Tim Reinbold on behalf of the Park District, and dated November 19, 2025 (“**Temporary Use Permit Application**”);
  2. Table 1 – 2026-2028 Park District Temporary events Details, consisting of one page, prepared by the Park District, and submitted to the City on December 15, 2025; and
  3. The Event Details Exhibit, consisting of 33 pages, prepared by the Park District, and submitted to the City on December 15, 2025 (“**Event Details**”).
- B. Location of Vendors; Direction of Traffic. Except as outlined in the Event Details, no vendors shall be located in the street. Only the Warrenville Police Department may direct traffic.
- C. Signs. All signage associated with the Events shall meet the requirements of the Warrenville Sign Ordinance.
- D. Refuse Removal. The Park District shall provide adequate trash receptacles and must monitor and promptly remove all trash from each Event area. Each Event location must be cleaned and all garbage removed at the end of each day.
- E. Vehicular and Pedestrian Access. Parking lot drive aisles, fire access routes, pedestrian walkways, and handicapped parking spaces must not be obstructed at any time during the Events.
- F. DuPage County Health Department. Vendors are responsible for obtaining all necessary approvals from the DuPage County Health Department.
- G. Sale of Alcohol; License Required. The Park District and vendors selling or serving alcohol must apply for and obtain the necessary City and State liquor license for each Event.
- H. Use of Utilities Prohibited. The unauthorized use of City Utilities, including water and electric service, is prohibited. Authorization to use said Utilities must be obtained from the City Deputy Public Works Director prior to the Event.
- I. Permits. The Park District shall be responsible for obtaining all required permits for the Events from the DuPage County Forest Preserve, DuPage County Division of Transportation, City of Warrenville, State of Illinois, or any other applicable entity.
- J. Tax Imposed. Unless otherwise approved by the City Council, any admission fee charged at an Event (e.g. fees charged for tickets or wrist bands) is subject to the applicable City 5% Amusement Tax, which shall be collected by the Park District and remitted to the City within one day following the Event, in accordance with the Warrenville City Code.

- K. Summer Daze. The Park District shall operate the Summer Daze Event in substantial conformance with the “Proposed Warrenville Summer Daze 2025” plan, included in the Event Details. Should tenant parking be required, the Park District shall submit an updated event plan at least two weeks before the Event.
- L. Inspection by the Warrenville Fire Protection District. All stages, tents, inflatables, rides, food tents, beer and wine tents used during the Events must be inspected by the Warrenville Fire Protection District.
- M. Insurance. For Events co-sponsored by the City, the Park District must submit a certificate of liability insurance, naming the City of Warrenville, including City Council, all elected and appointed officials, all employees and volunteers, and all boards, commissions and/or authorities and their board members, employees, and volunteers, as additional insured no later than one week prior to each Event. Vendors, bands, entertainment providers, and any other service or equipment providers must maintain sufficient insurance and provide a certificate of insurance naming the City of Warrenville, including City Council, all elected and appointed officials, all employees and volunteers, and all boards, commissioners and/or authorities and their board members, employees, and volunteers, as additional insured.
- N. Hold Harmless Agreement. The Park District must submit an executed hold harmless agreement in a form acceptable to the City no later than one week prior to each Event.

SECTION 4: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.

Summer Daze in Warrenville is an event sponsored by the City of Warrenville, Warrenville Park District and the Western DuPage Chamber of Commerce. This year will be the 48<sup>th</sup> year of this community festival which was first called the Car Show and was originally sponsored by the Warrenville Chamber of Commerce in cooperation with the City of Warrenville.

The Warrenville Park District took on the role of lead agency for the festival at the request of the City of Warrenville Mayor Brummel and Alderman Matt Weisbrook in 2010.

There is a Summer Daze committee that is vital to the organization of this event, and it consists of members from: City of Warrenville Staff, City of Warrenville Alderman, Warrenville Fire Department Chief, EMA Personnel, Warrenville Public Library Director, Warrenville Police Department, and NorthStar Credit Union personnel. The following Warrenville Park District staff are on the committee: Executive Director, Park Board Member, Superintendent of Parks and Planning, Superintendent of Recreation/Safety Coordinator, Fitness Supervisor, Athletic and Facility Supervisor, Finance Supervisor, Marketing/Special Event Supervisor and Office Manager.

The entertainment portion of the budget is funded by Hotel Grant Funding that consists of \$30,000. The rest of the event is funded by sponsors, funds raised during the event, and the Warrenville Park District's budget. None of the Warrenville Park District staffing expenses are funded by the Hotel Motel Grant Funding.

An additional \$11,000 Hotel Grant funds are also received and earmarked for the City of Warrenville personnel who are responsible for setting up the 10x10 tents, one 20x20 tent and tables for the food booths. The City personnel are also responsible for the garbage collection and electrical set up for the food booths and main stage. This funding also goes towards the police patrol for the event. Warrenville EMA assists with the street closings for the event.



Art on the Prairie is a weekend of arts in Warrenville featuring fine arts and crafts and musicians from the Midwest.

The festival hosts a wine and micro-brew tent along with pop/water sales. The alcohol vendors are responsible for obtaining the correct state and local liquor licenses. Food vendors (1-2 total food) are present throughout the festival.

The event brings together both the visual and performing arts for the community. This event is free.

**Event Hours:**

The event hours for the public are Saturday 10-6pm and Sunday 10am-4pm. Set-up begins at 7am each day with clean-up on Sunday until 7pm.

The event anticipates hosting 30-40 artist/vendors, 1 wine tent, 1 micro-brew tent and 2-3 food vendors.

The event hosts a performing arts stage and utilizes the Recreation Center parking lot and surrounding area for vendor booths, food, wine/beer tent, public seating and children's art tent.



## **Fall Fest 2026**

**Friday, October 23 at WPD Recreation Center – 6-9P**

Fall Fest is a community festival for families of all ages, not only Warrenville, but also the surrounding communities. The event is free for those wishing to attend, although, a minimal wrist band fee is charged for the children to play games and participate in the inflatable area. This event is supported by TAC dollars and is run by the Park District. In 2015 we included limited beer and wine and in 2018 we added a petting zoo. Due to the event being held at the Recreation Center only, we do not require any city streets to be closed for the event. The only areas that are closed are outside the building along the back parking lot for the food and beverage tent and petting zoo, which is included in the diagram.

350-400 trick-or-treat bags are given to children who purchase a wristband to play games and use the inflatables. NuMark Credit Union gives away 650 caramel apples. There are a lot of activities and things to do at Fall Fest such as games, inflatables, balloon twister, caricaturist, petting zoo and crafts. The outdoor tent area also provides an opportunity for people to get dinner or enjoy a drink while listening to a live music.

Registration is not taken at the event which makes it very difficult to track the amount of outside people that attend, but hundreds of people are generally in attendance.


### **Parade:**




